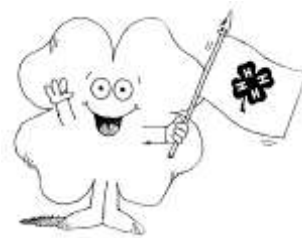


# Cloverbud Creative Fiber Arts Revue Tips

## *(Green Sheet)*

1. The evaluator will ask you some questions about what you made for the Creative Fiber Arts Revue. It would probably make you feel less scared or nervous if you practice answering these questions at home. Practice with your 4-H leader, your parent or older brother or sister a few minutes everyday during the week before the revue.



2. These are sample questions:

- a. What is your name? How old are you? What did you bring to show me?
- b. How did you make this?
- c. What will you use it for?
- d. What other things have you done in 4-H?

For second graders:

- e. How much did it cost to make this?
- f. What would you like to make next year?

3. Pretend you are on stage or in front of a crowd. Practice “showing off” the article you made. Hold it so the audience can see it well. As you are walking across the stage, turn it to your left and right so the people on your left and right sides can see it. Stop and hold it still for a moment before you “walk off the stage.” Smile all the time!



4. Parents or Leaders: A short 2 or 3 sentence commentary is needed for each Cloverbud. Include name, club, years in 4-H, what the child made, and how the child will use it.
