Requirements:

- A maximum of one (1) official 4-H charity animal per species will be allowed to sell in the auction.
- Limited to first member per species to receive approval from 4-H Educator.
- Member must commit and have approval at time of animal tag-in.
- Charity animal will follow the sale of the Reserve Grand Champion.
