**Here is a checklist of things for you to do when disbanding a 4-H club:**

- Contact the parents of the members in the club to let them know that you will no longer be able to lead the club and to find out if any of them are interested in leadership.
- Ask the parents to contact the 4-H Office if their child is still interested in being a 4-H member and they would like to have us look for another club for them.
- Return any items to the 4-H Office that were borrowed.
- Funds remaining in the club treasury should be donated to the County Awards Fund, 4-H Council, or a charitable organization. The 4-H Office should be notified of the amount and disposition of such funds and property.
